The first to run out was the delicious Reiga IPA 4.5%abv from Sheffield Brewery, this beer was a lovely example of their monthly special IPA range. Dr Tim Stillman, the Head Brewer of Sheffield Brewery co recommended this beer to us as being a popular choice for beer festivals due to its distinctive citrus aroma and its moreish flavours, how right he was as pint after pint flowed over the bar to thirsty festival goers. My personal favourite of the lot had to be Brampton Mild, a sweet, fruity mild at 4.9% abv. As this beer is normally in short supply, To make this available to for the beer festival, I had to buy it from a local bar, who luckily, had a cask in reserve from their previous beer festival, this beer ran out on Sunday afternoon.

The Saturday night proved very popular, The club was packed to the rafters from 5.30pm for the family disco, kids enjoying the games led by Phil and myself, parents enjoying lots and lots of beer from the festival bar and the food from Carol. 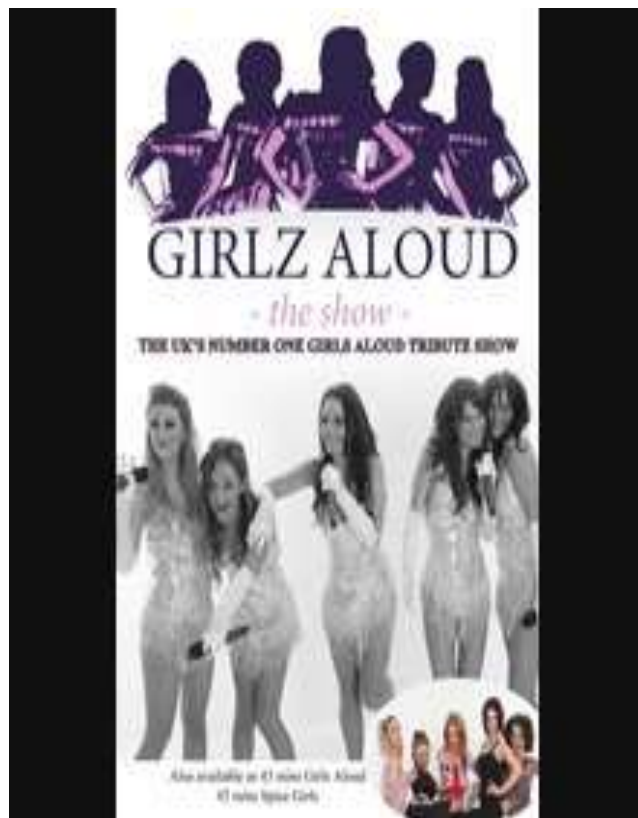
