India Pale Ale	Dronfield IPA	5.0	Dronfield Brewery	A Hoppy pale ale with Australian and American Hops. Fantastic flavours of Lychee, Soft Fruit and Elderflower follow a malty backbone and leaves with a long bitter finish balanced by some residual sweetness
HOMEYLOCUST	Honey Locust	4.5	Wood St Brewery	A honey infused pale ale, American hops combined with the aromas and honey flavours should be sweet on the palete with a citrus and lychee finish
Abar Errory  Openin River	Licorice Alesort	5.0	Ashover Brewery	Fruity, malty stout
(xb)	UXB	4.6	Abbeydale	Premium bitter with lots of dark malt flavours. Complemented by the fruitiness of the hops.
FORCEMASTERS	Forgemasters	4.8	Sheffield Brewery	A golden Pale Ale with a spicy, citrus aroma and a smooth refreshing finish
BARLOW BREWERY DHE'R HOTSE	Dark Horse	4.2	Barlow Brewery	A darker, malty, traditional English best bitter, plenty of malty flavours with all English hops
